



**JOINT RENDEZVOUS**  
**CBGBOA and MTOA Chesapeake Bay Cruisers**  
**Saturday, June 14, 2008**  
**Granary Creek (38.53.14, 76.08.35), Wye River, MD**

CBGBOA (Chesapeake Bay Grand Banks Owners Association) and MTOA (Marine Trawlers Owners Association) Chesapeake Bay Cruisers will hold a *first-ever joint rendezvous* at the **Wye Island Natural Resources Park**, overlooking Granary Creek, on Saturday, June 14, 2008. Vessels should anchor in Granary Creek and plan to dink to shore. Overflow anchorages, if needed, will be Dividing Creek (38.53.20, 76.09.30) or Quarter Cove (38.52.52, 76.09.00). Attendance by land vessel, including an overnight stay, is an option.

Early arrivals on Friday, June 13<sup>th</sup> are invited to join us at a social hour planned for 5:00 PM, held at the picnic area located at the head of the creek. Please bring an appetizer for about 6 people and your beverage of choice if you plan to be part of the Friday night social. Dinner, if you still want it, will be back at each individual's boat.

The facility use fee for Saturday's activities is \$5 per person which includes use of the park grounds (hiking, biking, kayaking, volleyball, horseshoes, nature watching), pavilion and hardwood fire grills for cooking. Please bring your own main course for grilling. Participants with last names ending in A-K, should bring a salad or side dish for 6 people and last names ending in L-Z bring desert for 6. Light breakfast will be available prior to departure on Sunday, June 15<sup>th</sup>.

A non-refundable facility use fee must be paid by Friday, May 16, 2008 in order to hold your reservation. Additional details will be provided at a later date.
